We've held one day BITS programs in area libraries as well as longer after-school programs at South Side, Thomas Paine, Garden Hills, Wiley School and Don Moyer's Boys & Girls Club. During the 2013 Champaign Blues, Brews & BBQ fest we sponsored workshop on harmonica and other instruments.
