

## **PCBS Agenda -10/14/21 Meeting Minutes**

### **Po' Boys**

**Present:** Bob Paleczny, Zach Widup, Mike Ball, Greg Altstetter, Jesse Howell, Kandra Miller

Zach distributed the Treasurer's Report and stated all bills for Fest expenses have not been submitted. As of 10/14/21 Assets were \$8941.82 (Note: Assets earmarked for education \$516.13.) Bob said Fest Insurance was \$300 that he paid.

### **Old Business:**

**Discussion of Lemke Sound Payment** for use of Steve Lemke's equipment at the PCBS Blues Fest held August 14 2021.

1. Per Bob, PCBS previously paid \$750.
2. Majority voted to offer \$750 this year.
3. PCBS Members suggested for the future, PCBS draw up a contract with a price agreement with Steve Lemke before the event.
4. Also suggested, if the Fest makes a profit, to offer an additional dollar bonus.

### **Fest T-Shirts Discussion**

1. Bob stated PCBS members are expected to contact their Sponsors for sizes and color choices OR if the sponsors want a tee-shirt.
2. Greg stated he would contact Weiskamp for prices. He, also, stated he did not feel the Sponsors made the donations dependent on the tee-shirt(s) and our Volunteers should understand. Tee-shirts just subtract from our bottom line. We should apologize and move on. Members present expressed agreement.

### **New Business:**

**Election of new Secretary D. Secretary: The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the General Membership or the Board of Directors. The minutes shall be read, unless dispensed with, and approved and kept available at each meeting. The Secretary shall perform other duties related to the office as designated by the President and approved by the Board of Directors.**
