Remembering Dave Faule – **Bob Paleczny announced that Dave Faule, saxophonist for Kilborn Alley, passed away March 8, 2022. PCBS will wait until we learn if Kilborn Alley plans a memorial. It was suggested to purchase one of his paintings on display at Po' Boys, to raffle it and to use the proceeds to honor him.**
